The Treatment Assessment Memorandum included an alternatives analysis for improving and expanding plant capacity utilizing the findings of the Facility Assessment Report. Based on

these evaluations, the District has elected to construct a new WTP, raw water pump station and pipeline. Included in the EA are details of the improvements, affected environmental impacts of the proposed project, and
