please be sure the decorations will last and to keep from littering

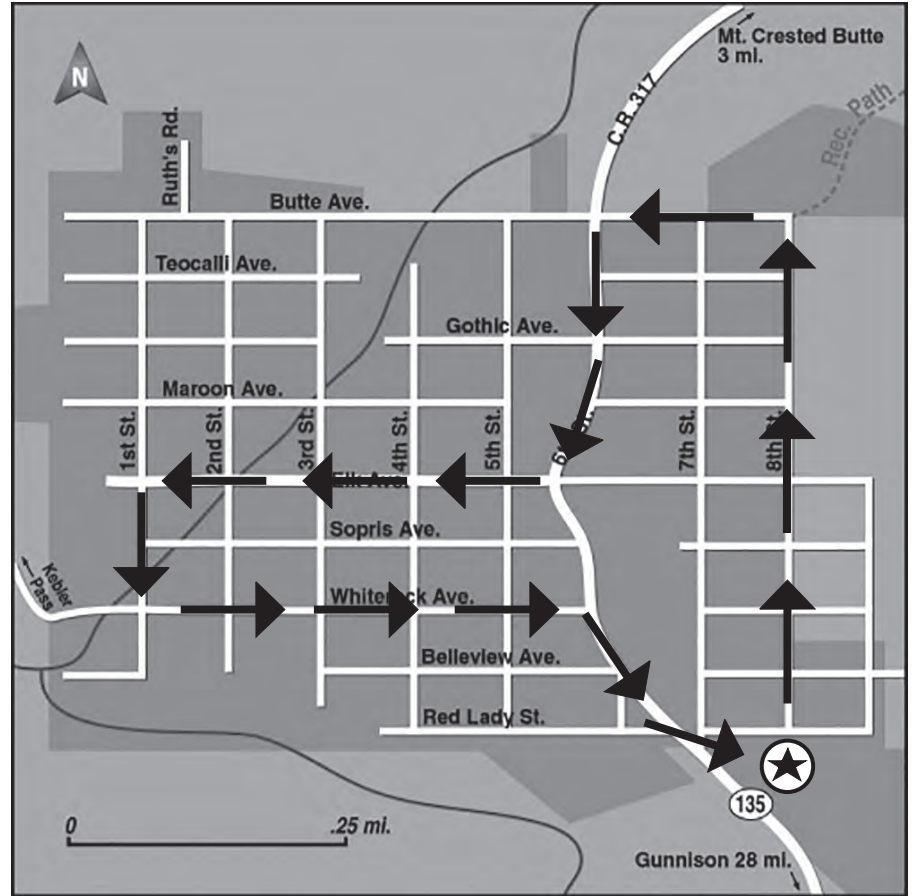
### SPECTATORS:

Your community is proud of you!

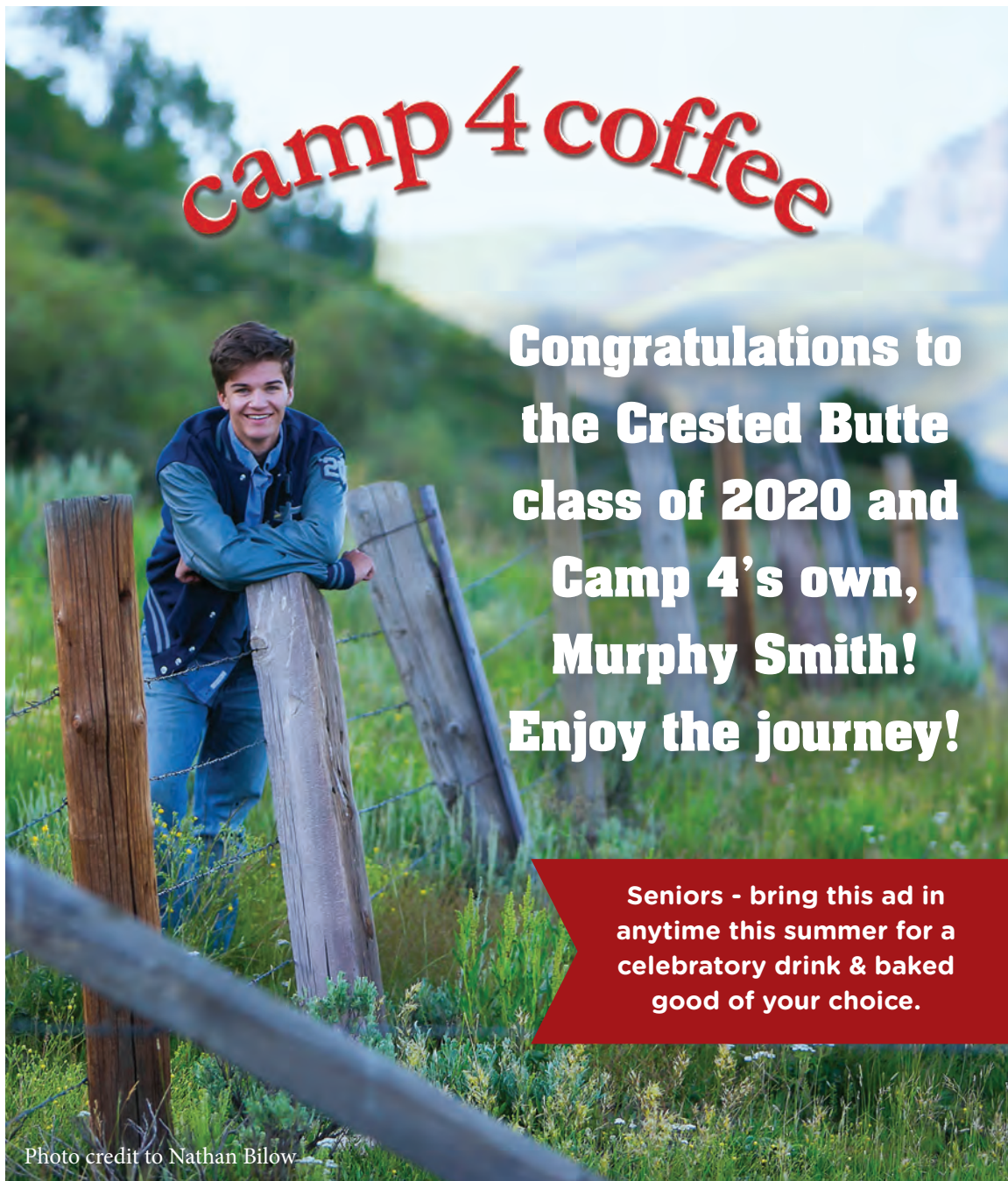



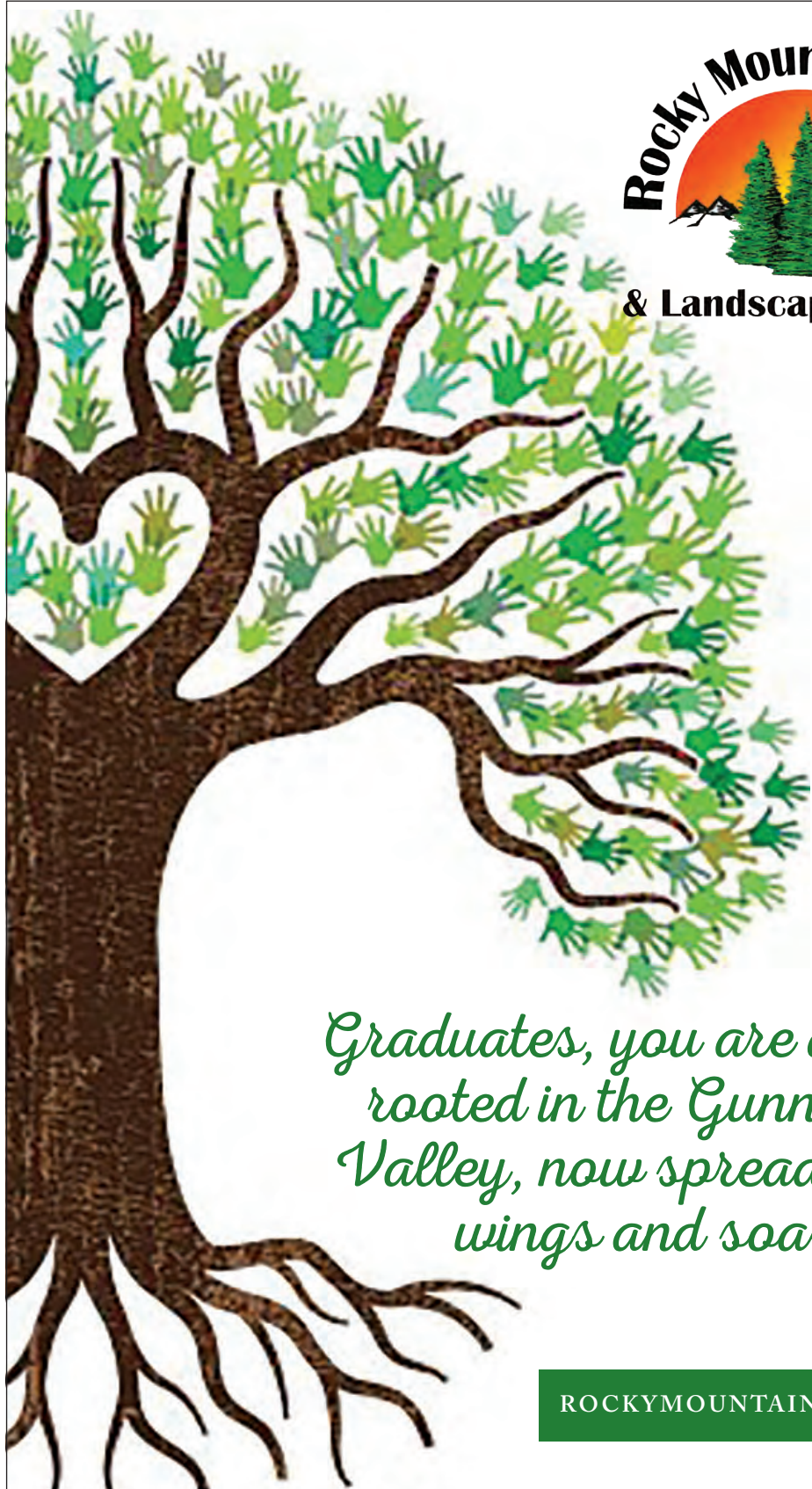
