Proposals for CMAR services for the Wastewater Treatment Plant Improvements Project (Project) will be received at the Town of Crested Butte Town Hall located at 507 Maroon Ave, Crested Butte, Colorado 81224, until December 22, 2021, at 4:00 pm local time. At that time the Proposals received will be publicly opened and read.

The Project includes the following Work: Wastewater treatment plant (WWTP) upgrades to the existing facility to replace aging infrastructure, revitalize existing assets, and provide improved operating conditions associated with

the secondary treatment process. The focus of these improvements will be improvements within the solids process building, replacement of equipment, and new solids process equipment, rehabilitation to the interior of the existing compost building, and construction of a new secondary treatment process building to enclose the existing aeration basins and provide administrative spaces for the operations staff.

Proposals are requested for the following CMAR services Contract: **Wastewater Treatment Plant Improvements Project**

Owner anticipates that the Project's total construction price will be approximately **\$12,000,000**, which is anticipated to be funded through a combination of State Revolving Loan Funds (SRF Funding), Department of Local Affairs Energy and Mineral Impact Grant funds,

and capital reserves. SRF specifications will need to be followed, including encouraging Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE's) and using Gunnison County Davis Bacon wages that will be locked once the Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) contract is signed. The Project has a preliminary expected construction completion date of December 31, 2023.

The Project includes the following Work:

Lake Irwin improvements to replace aging dam outfall piping and valving including the existing intake structure, intake timber set tunnel, valve shaft, and outfall pipeline. The Town is currently considering two options for improvements, including complete replacement of all facilities and partial replacement leaving a portion of existing infrastructure in-place. The final system configuration will be selected as part of the final design.

Proposals are requested for the following CMAR services Contract: **Lake Irwin Valve and Piping Project**

Owner anticipates that the Project's total construction price will be approximately **\$1,600,000** and is dependent on final design decisions. This project is anticipated to be funded through a combination of Colorado Water Conservation Board funds, Colorado River District funds, and capital reserves. The Project is anticipated to be constructed in 2022 and shall be completed within one construction season occurring over a three (3) month period between June and November when site access is feasible.
