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Raymond also asks that fans only use the bridge across the river at the Oh Be Joyful campground and remain on that side of the creek, also known as "river left."

"We don't want people river right (on the right bank when looking downstream), we want people hiking up from Oh Be Joyful," says Raymond. "And respect all the boundaries."

As for conditions, Raymond believes things should be great come race day with flows predicted to be at the high end of medium.

"With our snow-pack and the recent weather, it's looking really, really good," says Raymond. Raymond is expecting around 30 rac-

ers to register this year, both men and women, and the first of two runs is set to be at noon, with the second run around 2 p.m. Thanks to the support each and every year of Rob and Sydney Dickinson with Precise Painting as well as Eddyline Brewery, Deerhammer Distilling and a host of equipment companies jumping in this year. There's cash on the line for the top three and prizes for fourth through sixth place for both men and women. In addition, the BOOF belt buckle is up for grabs for "Best Boof."

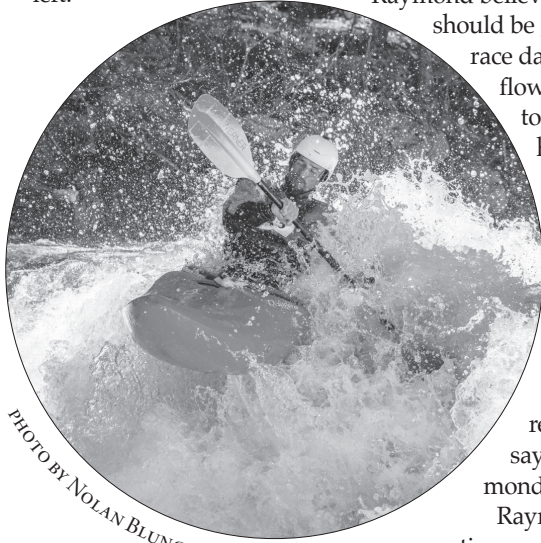
