2023 PARADE:

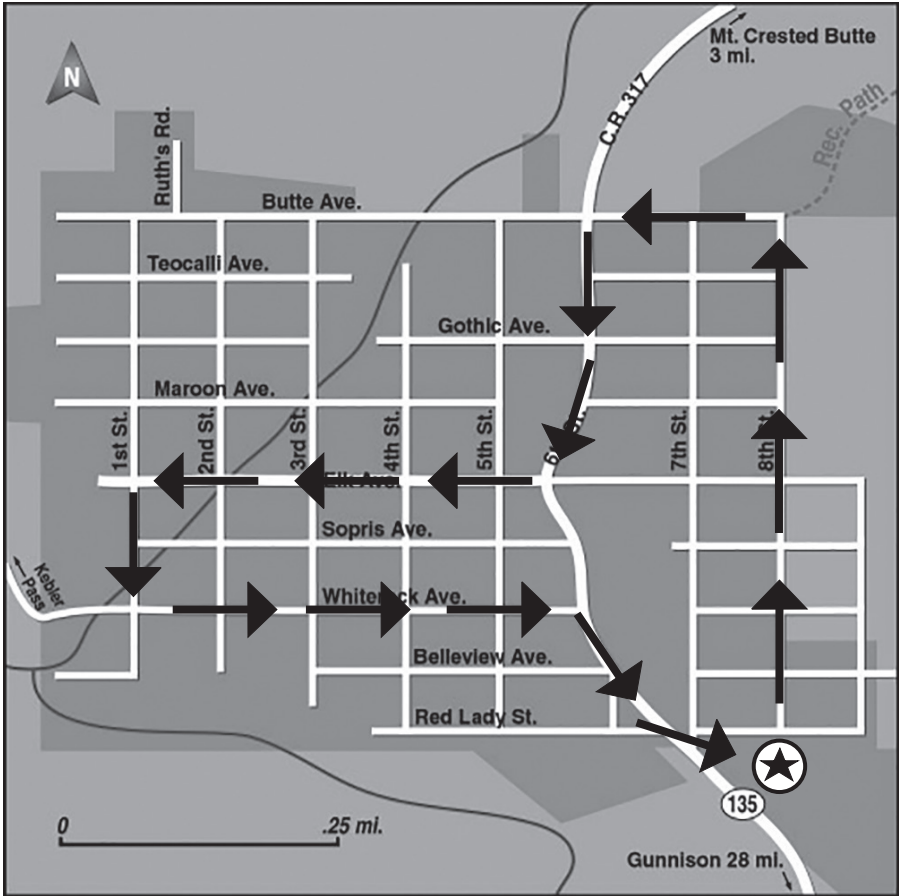
The Class of 2023 will begin their celebratory cruise through town at approximately 11:30 a.m. on Saturday, May 27. Come out and cheer them on!

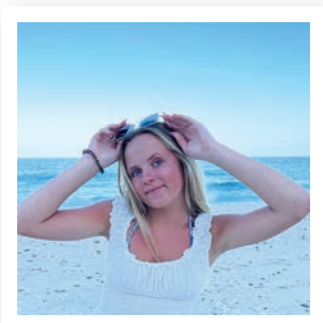

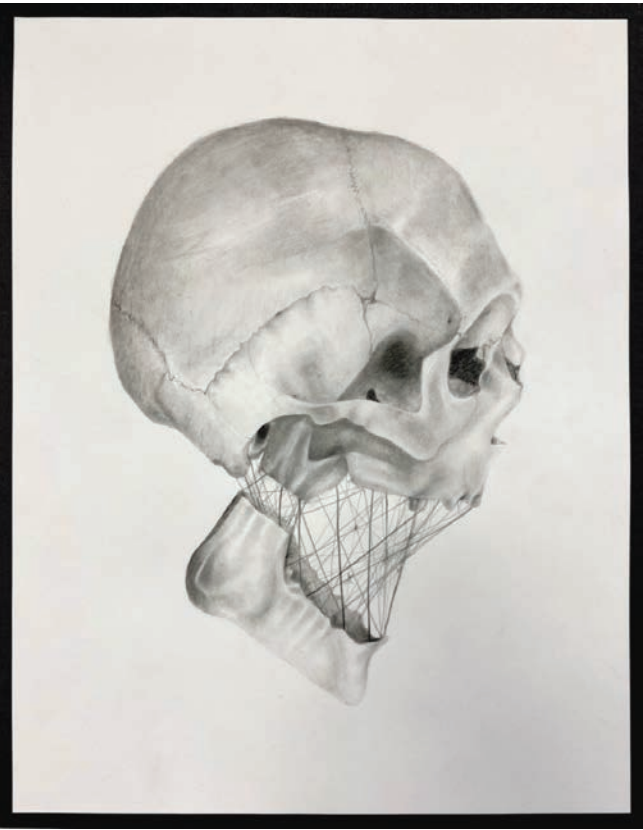

ARTIST STATEMENT

My artwork represents growth. From the time that I started my portfolio to where I am now, I have changed as a person more than I ever thought I would. Throughout most of high school I have struggled with severe depression and anxiety. This has made these past few years more difficult than I can put into words. This portfolio of artwork represents this dark time of my life, and the completion of the portfolio also represents the ending of this period. This is something that I never thought I would be able to say. After nearly losing my twin sister in 2021, I was put in the most surreal and horrible place I could have ever imagined. I want to emphasize the surreal aspect. I know that life endeavors will not end, but these pieces of art strongly represent my young mind experiencing these times. I draw realistic graphite and charcoal bones, and add surreal aspects to each of them. When taken out of normal or scientific context, I think that these bones can look very surreal just on their own. It has helped me view these parts of myself and my life in a more beautiful light, whilst still representing them in a way that can accurately depict the complex experiences.



Bones are the structures that keep each of us standing, and representing these bones being manipulated in different ways has been a way for me to represent mind-warping emotions. I hope that these pieces can make you think deeper (even just a tiny bit) into these unexplainable emotions each of us humans experience.
