

In Memory of Michael Grazier

I recently received the sad news from longtime friends Danny Byron and GJ Santelli that Micheal Grazier had passed. He was my ski idol, an amazing athlete and my uncle.

Michael enjoyed celebrity status for his daring, yet graceful ability on skis. He was a charismatic performer, and his stunts were often the first of their kind. From smooth ballet moves on to "hotdog" tricks to spectacular jumps he was a pioneer of the sport and a one-of-a-kind ski phenomenon.

He was a member of a freestyle Hot-Dog Team called "The Flying Bambini Brothers," a group of guys from Western State College back in the '70s, who were all exceptional skiers and probably best known for their daring 10-man backflip (a gainer) while holding hands in 1974. How

they pulled it off is still beyond me, and you can bet that there were injuries involved! GJ Santelli captured the photo which is truly spectacular.

Michael was the stunt skier in many of the ski movies made in CB back in the '70s, most notably, *The Snowball Express*.

He performed his most well-known feat on skis in 1971, pulling off the first known triple gainer (three backward flips while flying through the air on skis) and landing it. He made this celebrated jump during the 1971 Flauschink Gelende Contest on tower nine.

One of my favorite memories of Mike was his ability to teach the art of skiing to youths in a ski camp he developed in the late seventies called "Michael Grazier's Flight Camp." As a teen I followed (poached) many of his

classes and became a huge fan of mogul skiing.

I enjoyed other perks, like using his trampolines that were for his flight school students, an exciting family Thanksgiving with freestyle champion Suzie Chaffee "Chapstick" and the honor of meeting Wayne Wong as well as the Flying Bambini Brothers.

He had my cousins, Hayes and Jade on skis before they had even learned to walk. Uncle Mike definitely brought some fun and excitement to the sport of skiing and to our little ski area at the time and I feel grateful to have had him in my life.

Fly in Peace, Michael, and may you continue to do some amazing tricks in Heaven.
